**Form I Measures to Provide Warning to the Population**

Article 7.1 "Each State Party shall report to the Secretary-General on:

- i) The measures taken to provide an immediate and effective warning to the population in relation to all areas identified under paragraph 2 of Article 5."

*Remark:* In accordance with Article 5, para.2: "Each State Party shall make every effort to identify all areas under its jurisdiction or control in which anti-personnel mines are known or suspected to be emplaced and shall ensure as soon as possible that all anti-personnel mines in mined areas under its jurisdiction or control are perimeter-marked, monitored and protected by fencing or other means, to ensure the effective exclusion of civilians, until all anti-personnel mines contained therein have been destroyed. The marking shall at least be to the standards set out in the Protocol on Prohibitions or Restrictions on the Use of Mines, Booby-Traps and Other Devices, as amended on 3 May 1996, annexed to the Convention on Prohibitions or Restrictions on the Use of Certain Conventional Weapons Which May Be Deemed to Be Excessively Injurious or to Have Indiscriminate Effects".

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All mined areas are fenced and marked accordingly. Also, law enforcement officials are tasked to inform the public about the mined areas periodically; commanders in charge of military installations in proximity to minefields, post informative posters on public buildings (health centers, schools, terminals, places of worship, coffee houses), makes the necessary announcements and organizes public meetings in smaller residential areas. Similarly, warnings are issued by religious officials in places of worship and local TV and radio stations are used to disseminate information with regard to mined areas.

**Form J Other Relevant Matters**
