




- AG/RES.2181(XXXVI-O/06); "Support for Action Against Mines in Peru and Ecuador.












BACKGROUND

- Agreement signed between the Government of Suriname and the Organization of American States to assist with the following:
 - ▶ Clearance of Suriname's remaining minefield;
 - Develop the demining capacity of the Surinamese Army;
 - Return mine-affected land to productive use.

- First mine located on 15 February 2005.
- Trained Suriname Demining Unit integrated with Honduran deminers on 10 March 2005.
- Trained Suriname Demining Unit take over operations and departure of Honduran team on 19 March 2005. (International Supervisor Remains)
