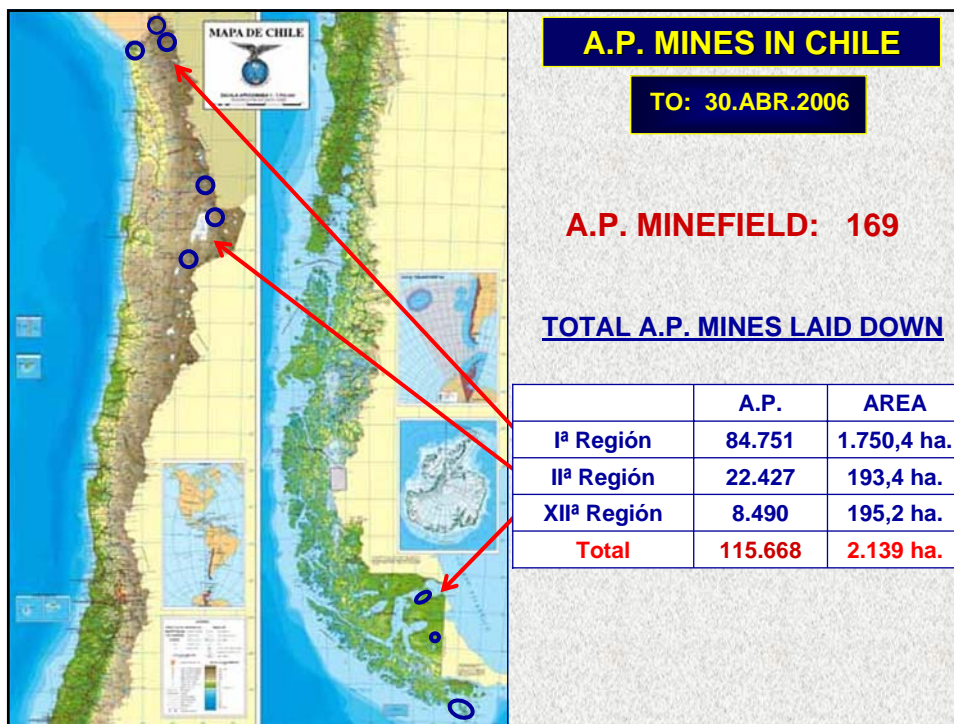


EUROPEAN UNION
