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First Aid saving lives and limbs

- Everyone has the potential to protect and save a life or a limb injured by mines
- This capacity for individuals and communities to be prepared and to help themselves should be available for ALL – First aid training and basic kits





What is First Aid?

- Life protection and life saving ACTIONS — not only training
- Caring, voluntary humanitarian
 act not only knowing
- Initial and effective response but also preparedness

TEN key points

- Call for help
- Safety
- Airway and Breathing
- Circulation Stop the bleeding
- Keep the victim warm



Continued.....

- Transportation
- Psychosocial support
- Oral fluid replacement
- Intravenous treatment
- Pain relief



First aid

- Immediate FIRST help
- Simple and effective
- Excellent impact with GOOD primary and secondary care
- Different from paramedic
- Easy to learn and apply
