- Field evacuation if we are available in the area
- Paying all the Medical costs
- Follow-up the case and provide all the assistance needs
- Provide the artificial limbs or any needs
 - Including the victim on the list which will be sent to the Ministry of Social Affairs and YALS

According to exam report, we provide corrective amputation surgery, physical therapy, prosthesis fitting, medical equipment such as wheel chairs, hearing aids, glasses, crutches or other walking devices
All expenses are covered by National Mine Action Program including transportation and hotel, food, and daily allowance for the survivors and their escorts.

Reintegrate the survivors in the productive society Through

- Teaching the survivors any profession (like stitching, hoses, embroidery decoration, needlework etc.)
