


Summary

 Retained 1,938 APMs for training purposes



- The stockpiles destruction in Khartoum was funded by GONU with limited technical assistance from UNDP
- The stockpiles destruction in Juba was supported by GOSS, UNDP, Canada and UN Mine Action Office

Challengees, lessons learned

- The commitment and political will from the CPA partners proved to be determining factors in this process
- As no proper records have been maintained, determining the exact number and types of AMPs was a challenge
- Due to poor infrastructure in most parts of the country collection and transportation of APMs was difficult and costly
- costy The financial assistance from Canada through UNDP and the technical assistance from UNMAO in Juba were crucial factors GONU did not receive any financial assistance form any
- Long rainy seasons delayed the transportation of APMs for several months.
