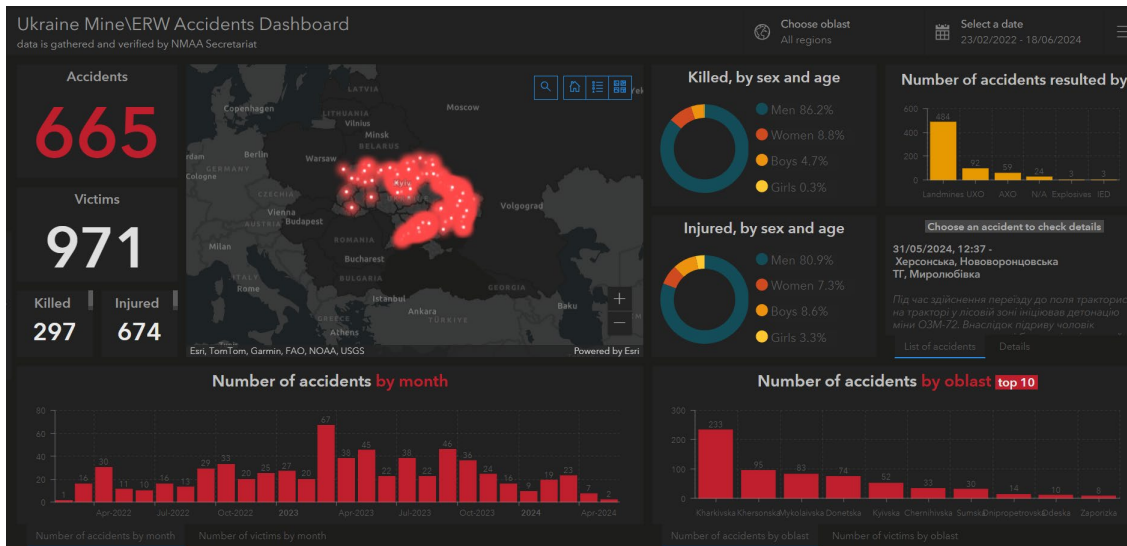




EO accidents & Victims in Ukraine since February 24, 2022, start of full scale invasion of russian federation against Ukraine

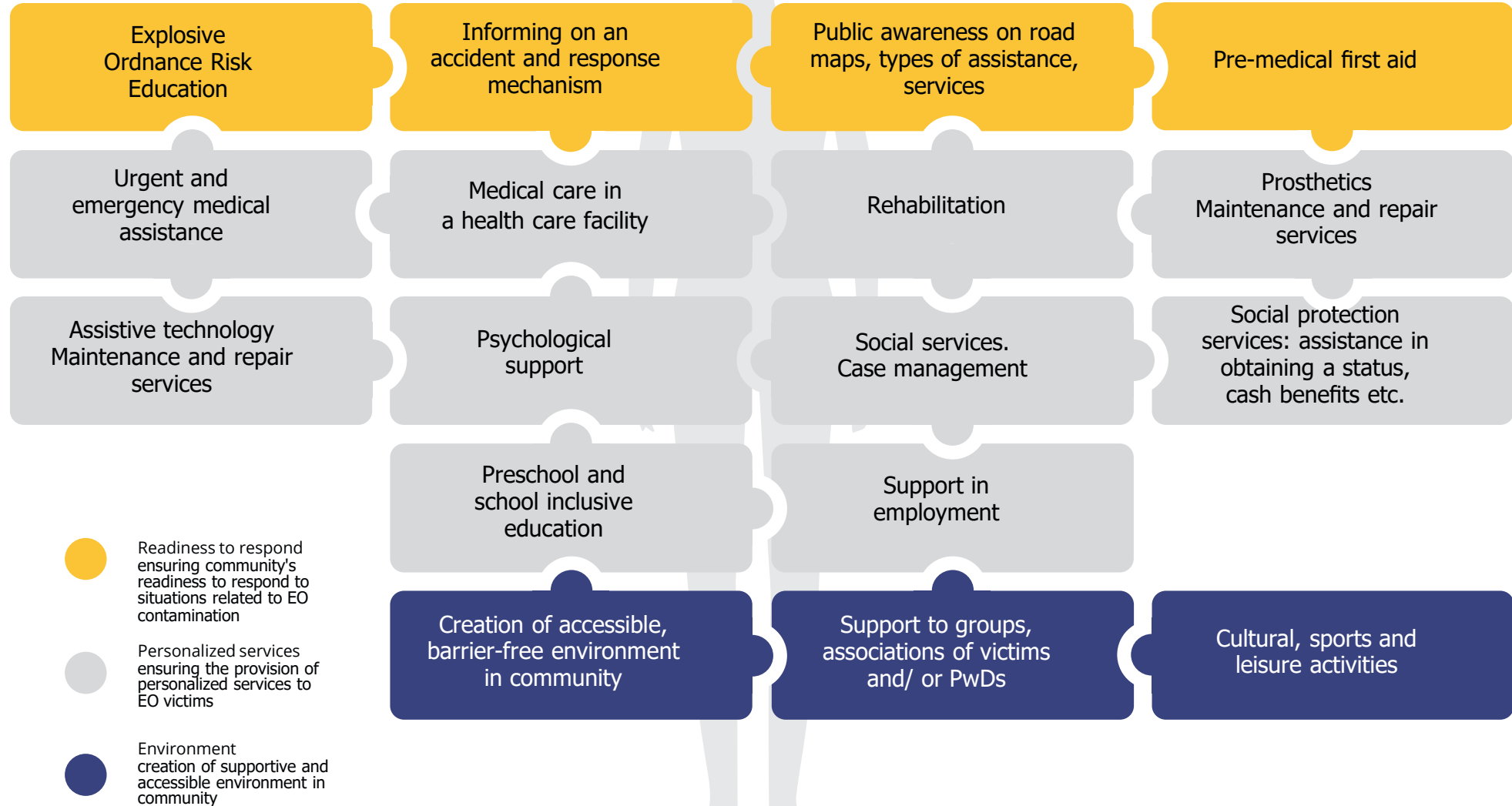

- Ensure continuous integration of victim assistance into national policies and legal frameworks
- Raising public awareness of victim assistance services
