In the scope of assistance, the country has a coordination mechanism, the National Social Action Council, which has been fundamental in sharing updated information on sectoral activities and financial resources available in the actions developed. It is important to continue with cooperation efforts so that actions are effective in assisting mine victims.

This mechanism is made up of government institutions, civil society, the private sector as well as cooperation partners who have provided technical and financial assistance in different programs, and it is also necessary to improve the planning process so that it is more inclusive and technical approaches concerning removal of barriers that still affect people with disabilities and victims of mines.
