

Press guidelines



Media Rules and Regulations*

- Plenary sessions are on the record and open to the media. Film/video/audio recording is allowed according to the following rules below:
 - Media professionals interested in being in the front of the room must contact the Communications Unit prior to attending, and must be in position 15 minutes prior to session.
 - Pictures, video and audio may be taken at any time from the back of the room. Cameras are not allowed to roam the room during the meeting unless it is done discreetly through the side lines or when escorted by a Media Liaison Officer. Media members may not at any time block the view of any of the participants in the meeting.
 - Journalists may discreetly approach participants to request interviews when delegates are not speaking, or otherwise engaged in discussion, although all journalists are strongly encouraged to seek the assistance of the Communications Unit with their request.
 - All interviews must be conducted outside the plenary room and in a way that does not disrupt the work of the plenary or any other meeting in progress.
 - All lunchtime side events (i.e., 12:00 to 14:00) are open to the media unless otherwise indicated. However, due to space constraints should you wish to record or photograph these sessions, please contact Ms. Laila RODRIGUEZ so that proper arrangements may be made.
